Sub:-Fixation of norms/guidelines for issuance of 'No Objection Certificate ' for installation of Shali Machines (Hullar/Sheller Type)>

Government Order No. 30-FS of 2003 Dated:- 04-04-2003

In supercession of all circular instruction and Govt. orders on the subject, following guidelines/norms are laid down for issuance of "No Objection Certificate" for installation of shall Machines (Hullar/Sheller) Type.

- The paddy production for installation of Hullar type should be 1600 qtls. In the village and 16000 qtls. For sheller type in a Patwar Halqa.
- Executive Engineer Electric should issue a certificate that the power required for running the tunit will be made available.
- Viii. SHO of the concerned Police station shall certify that the prospective owner of such unitor any member of his family is not a grain dealer or a profiteer of a hoarder.
 - iv. No Objection Certificate from District Industries centre of the District.
 - v. NOC from Power Development Department with regard to clearance of power tariff.
 - vi. NOC from the Pollution Control Board in case the applicant intendent of install his unit on diesel generator.
 - NOC from the head of a Govt./Public/Religious institution located in the vicinity of the proposed installation.
 - viii. Applicant shall furnish necessary affidavit duly attested by Magistrate Notary that he will install a modernized shall machine.
 - Papers regarding title verification of the land obn which the unit is to be installed.
- Preference will be given to educated un-employed Youth of the village where the shall machine is proposed to be installed.

No Objection certificate shall be issued by Director Food and SuppliesJammu/Kashmir strictly in accordance with the above guidelines and no the recommendations of Dy. Commissioner concerned.

The Deputy commissioner concerned shall issue license as per the past practice after charging licence fee renewal fee/and fine prescribed vide Government Order No:59-FS if 2001 dated:03.10.2001 and 31-FS of 2002 dated:13.06.2002.
